

Gamecube fspd.exe

usage: fspd.exe [-h] [-a ADDRESS] [-p PASSWORD] [-d DIRECTORY]

This is a python script converted to a windows executable to automate running the fspd server easier.

the included fspd.bat need to be edited to your preferences and network setup.

anti virus might flag this as harmful , but it is a false positive. most likely cause its a python script embedded in a exe. it was compiled using "auto-py-to-exe". You can compile it yourself if you so wish.

install the latest python for windows, make sure you check add path to windows at the end of the setup.

open a cmd prompt and type "pip install auto-py-to-exe"

after its finished installing, type "auto-py-to-exe"

- Change "192.168.1.1" to the network IP of the PC you will be running it on.
- Change "1234" to the desired port of your choosing.
- Change "password" to one of your choosing.
- Change the "C:\where\my\games\are" to the directory where you have backed up your games to.
