About:

PS1CardLink is a software for the PlayStation and PSOne consoles which acts as a firmware allowing you to turn a console into a Memory Card reader. It requires an official or home made TTL serial cable for communication with PC.

While PSOne doesn't have exposed serial port test points still exist on it's board so it can be used with PS1CardLink.

On the PC side a MemcardRex software can be used to talk with console.

Hardware requirements:

USB-TTL adapter connected to RX, TX and GND points of PlayStation serial port.
PlayStation capable of booting burned CD-Rs (modchip, swap method or cheat cartridge).

Software requirements:

ImgBurn or other burning software.
MemcardRex 1.8+.

Disclaimer:

You are doing this on your own risk. The author (Shendo) is not responsible if you fry your equipment or you lose all your saves on the Memory Card.

Instructions:

Burn the Ps1CardLink ISO image to a blank CD-R and run the software on your console.

When you see a GUI of the application connect a Memory Card to either slot and use controller so select it.

Open MemcardRex and go to Options->Preferences and set up COM port.

Now you can use hardware options in MemcardRex to communicate with device.
