

Disclaimer: I don't know if this works for Linux games in other formats as well because I haven't tried that yet. Also all of these steps have to be taken in Desktop mode

So this time I'm going to explain to you how you can play Linux games in .sh format

1. Open the folder of the downloaded game
2. Locate the .sh file
3. Right click on the file and **add it to Steam**
4. Open your Steam Library
5. Locate your game in the Steam Library
6. Click on the cog icon
7. Go to **Properties**
8. Go to **Compatibility**
9. Confirm **Force the use of a specific Steam Play Compatibility tool**
10. Once you've confirmed it **Steam Linux Runtime 1.0 (scout)** should be pre-selected automatically. Do **not** change this. This runner is needed to play Linux files in .sh format
11. Now click on play and the game should open up
